Territory. Territory means a region wherein access to and use of the software will be controlled by a Single Customer license server at the installation site; available on customer's local area network shared by a grouping of Customer's facilities within ten (10) miles of the installation site. Customer may not access the Software outside of the Territory without ESRD's prior written consent.

License to Use. ESRD grants to Customer a non-exclusive and non-transferable license for personal, corporate or academic use only of the accompanying software and documentation and any error corrections provided by ESRD in the Territory for the purpose of processing Customer's own internal business. Customer has no right to distribute the Software without a separate license agreement from ESRD.
